- Maintain <270 lbs. weight
- Be drug free
- Pass pre-employment testing
- Electrical Lineworker Apprentice Certification (ELAC) through a technical college is highly desirable

#### **Pre-Employment Testing**

- Construction and Skilled Trade Test (CAST) -Measures math problem-solving, comprehension of mechanical principles, and reading comprehension
- Post-Offer Employment Test (POET) physical abilities assessment
